On January 1, 2010, the residents of the City of Peoria will have a new garbage collection provider. PDC Services, Inc. (PDC) will be the solid waste collector for the disposal of residential garbage, landscape waste and recyclables in the City of Peoria. The City Council endorsed the company's proposal in October 2009 that offers the same quality services that residents have come to expect plus the addition of a new recycling service at no charge. Garbage Collection

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW



Set out the garbage after 3:00 p.m. the day before pick-up or before 6:00 a.m. the day of collection.



City of Peoria ordinance requires that all emptied garbage containers must be removed from the curb or alley within 24 hours after pick-up.



Use plastic containers with handles and tight-fitting lids. You can rent a roll-out cart from PDC for \$2.50 per month by calling, 674-5176, select option #1.



Do not overfill containers. Containers weighing more than 50 lbs. will not be collected.



Place your container(s) within 3 feet of the curb or alley line.



Unacceptable items:

- Freon/grease/motor oil/antifreeze
- Paint (liquid form)
- Biohazardous waste
- Industrial cleaners/solvents

Holidays

PDC observes the following six holidays:

New Year's Day • Memorial Day

On holidays, service will be delayed by one (1) day with Saturday as a catch-up date.

Garbage pick-up will occur on the following holidays:

When in doubt, put it out!

Bulky Items Bigger items are collected weekly.

Furniture You can place a furniture item with your garbage. For numerous furniture items or exceptionally large pieces, contact PDC in advance by calling 674-5176, select option #1.

Building Materials Only small amounts of residential building materials are accepted and must be from the property where the materials are placed for collection. Materials should be cut into 5-foot lengths, bundled with twine or rope, and not weigh more than 50 lbs.

Fruit & Vegetable Plants Plants with produce, regardless of maturity and decay, will be collected as garbage. Plants without any produce can be pick up as yard waste.

Miscellaneous If possible, disassemble items like swing sets. Also, remove toilet tank from stool and concrete from poles.

Yard Waste Collection

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

Yard waste collection begins on the third Monday in March, March 15, 2010, and ends the third Friday in December, December 17, 2010.

Yard waste is collected on a weekly basis, the same day as garbage collection.

Yard waste consists of grass, leaves, tree limbs and/or brush. Limbs and brush must be in approved yard waste bags or cut and tied in bundles no longer than 5-feet in length weighing no more than 50 lbs.

Please use only non-plastic/non-metallic rope, twine or other binding string.

Please do not mix yard waste with household waste or animal waste.

Fruit and vegetable plants will be picked up as yard waste if all produce is completely removed from the plant.

Yard Waste Containers

Use one of the following:

- 30-gallon biodegradable paper yard waste bags weighing no more than 50 lbs.
- 95-gallon roll-out cart weighing no more than 50 lbs.
- Customer's own container should not exceed 45 gallons.

95-Gallon Roll-Out Cart Rental

You can use your own garbage container as long as it is no more than 45 gallons in size. You can also rent or buy a 95-gallon roll-out cart through the PDC for your garbage and yard waste needs.
